The **PCA** helps our League provide a positive sports experience for all of its young athletes. Everyone must work together to assure the program is successful. Your attendance at the **PCA Parent Workshop** will be a critical part of that success and is required. Based on the number of parents at the **Parent Workshop**, your child's team will be awarded a game win or loss.

Thank you for signing up with the Christian Athletic League, Inc. We hope your child’s baseball experience is enjoyable and fulfilling. We are an all-volunteer organization giving children the opportunity to participate in an organized baseball program without all the politics associated with other youth sports. **Please refer to the Player and Parent Handbook received at registration for more information regarding our League.** Every tball player and each player on the 1st place teams in the Farm, Minor, and Major divisions will receive a trophy at the end of the season; players on the 2nd place teams will receive a medal. Players in Farm through Majors also compete in the post season tournament where they may win a trophy. We will not provide participation trophies to every player. We also offer a CAL All-Stars Tournament Game at the end of the season; two teams coached by the 1st and 2nd place managers are comprised of players from every team in each division as voted by their teammates (participation is not mandatory; a fee applies); players from each regular season team will be evenly divided between the all star teams.

No refunds for any registration fee will be issued after February 15, 2019. Raffle tickets are not refundable at anytime

We are continuing our partnership with the Positive Coaching Alliance (PCA). All managers and coaches receive PCA training in February, and parents attend a one-hour PCA training session on **March 12, 2019**. The PCA helps our League provide a positive sports experience for all of its young athletes. Everyone must work together to assure the program is successful. **Your attendance at the PCA Parent Workshop will be a critical part of that success and is expected.** Based on the number of parents at the Parent Workshop, your team will be awarded one game win. The parent workshop will be held on **March 12, 2019**, please plan to attend - you already paid the fee to attend this clinic with your child’s registration.

Additional parents and player supporters are also welcome - Advanced notice is required to receive materials (\$5.00 each).

VOLUNTEERS: **Volunteers are essential to this League.** Each team needs volunteers throughout the season for various tasks, including managers, coaches, team parent, field preparation and clean-up, snack bar duty, and scorekeepers. We are counting on every parent to sign-up for AT LEAST one position for their team. ***Based on points earned for volunteering, your child’s team will be awarded one game win or loss which counts toward their overall season win/loss record.*** *The Volunteer Point win is up to YOU so be sure to sign up with your team manager or team parent representative for how you can help the team and the League.*

FUNDRAISING: Each player is responsible for a minimum of \$90.00 in fundraising (or \$80.00 if sibling). Fundraising helps reduce registration fees by offsetting the real cost of putting this baseball program together (equipment, insurance, maintenance and utilities for the fields at Divine Word, umpires, trophies, and opening and closing ceremonies). *All donations may be tax deductible as the Christian Athletic League is a state and federal non-profit, tax-exempt corporation. Please note the new lower ad rates! You choose your fundraising option:

- (1) Yearbook ad(s) and/or memory spot(s): \$20 business card size, \$30 1/4 page size, \$60 1/2 page size, \$100 full page.
- (2) Full or Partial Buyout payment (you still have an opportunity to submit an ad or memory page for the yearbook if you buy out).
- (3) Candy Sale: Turn in \$60 per box for \$30 credit toward fundraiser (\$30 per box pays for the candy and \$30 per box is fundraising credit).
1 box = 60 bars @ \$1 each (get \$30 credit toward fundraising for every \$60 in candy money turned in),
2 boxes = 120 bars (turn in \$120 for \$60 credit), or 3 boxes = 180 bars (turn in \$180 for \$90 credit).
- (4) Any combination of ads, candy sale, or cash buyout payment to equal fundraising requirement.

If you want to sell candy (1, 2, or 3 boxes) for fundraising credit, you needed to indicate how many boxes on your registration form so we can order the candy in advance. **The candy sale will run during February with money due March 2, 2019.** **All sponsor ads/memory spots will also be due March 2, 2019 (including all artwork and payment).** Ads may be paid for in advance (no later than March 2, 2019), but prepaid artwork will be accepted until April 6, 2019. *Please note that ads must be ready for placement in the yearbook (ready-to-scan or digital) - what you turn in is what gets scanned into the book. The League does not prepare individual ads.*

Also, 75% of any **extra fundraising** money collected above the total of a team’s player minimum requirement goes toward that team for practice fields, team parties, jackets, batting cages, etc. It is a great benefit for the kids and the program when families go above and beyond with their fundraising. *Prizes will be awarded to the individuals who raise the most!*

Raffle tickets cost \$1.00 each; a minimum of 10 tickets must be purchased with registration. Enter the tickets with your name or a family member’s name for a chance to win, or sell them to get your money back (you’ve already paid for them, so it is your choice). Additional raffle tickets may be purchased for \$1.00 each at signups or on Opening Day. Great prizes will be raffled off, such as a child’s bicycle, video game system, gift certificates, sports gear, and much more!

PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

As a parent and player supporter, you play a special role in contributing to the needs and development of the children. Our main theme is for everyone to “Honor the Game”.

Through your encouragement and good examples, you can help assure that all the boys and girls learn good sportsmanship and self discipline.

1. Children want to have fun! Remember that your child is playing the game, not you. It’s very important to let the children establish their own goals - to play the game for themselves. Take care not to impose your own goals and standards on them.
2. Children play for the fun of playing. Cheer positively for the things you like and encourage your team. But remember, too many voices may confuse your child. Let the coaches do the coaching and the umpires do the umpiring. Remember, Have fun!
3. Never put down the other team, one of your child’s teammates, or your own child.
4. The size of a baseball diamond and the continuous nature of the game seriously diminish the effectiveness of sideline coaching. Leave the managing and coaching to the managers and coaches.
5. The umpires are professionals, but they are also human. While their decisions may not always be agreeable to all, their decisions are final. No useful purpose is served by shouting disagreement or derogatory remarks. Such action could be cause for termination of the game, and result in a forfeit for your team.
6. Every year we have new managers and coaches. Each is volunteering to do a difficult job and mistakes will occur. Thank them for devoting their time and effort to teaching your child. Harassing the managers, coaches, or umpires is unwarranted and will not be tolerated.
7. Along with snack bar refreshments comes litter. We ask your help in keeping the fields neat and clean by disposing of the litter and all other trash properly.
8. City, school, and league policies prohibit the consumption of alcoholic beverages and smoking while on or near playing or practice fields. Smoking must be confined to within your car.
9. PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED (regardless of size or type) at the Divine Word facility or City practice fields. Please leave your pets at home and please respect the rules.
